



# HEALTHY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Researchers at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) in Bethesda, Maryland seek healthy volunteers age five and older to join in a research study. Near-infrared spectroscopy (NIRS) and/or electroencephalography (EEG) may be used to study brain activity. Learning how the brain controls muscles may help design treatments to help patients to move better.

## You may qualify for this study if you (or your child):

- Are at least 5 years old.

## Study participation includes:

- Physical exam and medical history
- At least one session of NIRS and/or EEG with sensors placed on the scalp
- Parents must give permission for minors to participate
- Compensation is provided
- There is no charge for study-related assessments
